RBdigital is a state-of-the-art platform and app providing access to **audiobooks, e-Books, e-Magazines, comics, software tutorials, films and music** all in one place.

Step 1: Visit library.britishcouncil.org and click on **My Account** and use your membership credentials to log in.

Step 2: Click on any of the links of **ebooks, Audiobooks, Magazines, Comics, Software Training, Independent Films, or Concerts.**

Step 3: Click the Sign in option in the top right corner of the main page and enter your details to proceed.

Step 4: If you are accessing the RBdigital platform for the first time, click on Register now

Step 5: Select your country when you choose your library

Step 6: Enter your details to create your login credentials and then click on register. You will now be able to log in and access the resources





Once you've set up your account, you can stream **Movies (Indieflix)**, **Tutorials (Hoonuit)** and **Music (Qello)** through your browser.

Ebooks Central provides access to the largest selection of quality, multidisciplinary titles from world-renowned publishers. Explore focused, academic ebook collections at your fingertips.

Step 1: Visit library.britishcouncil.org and click on **My Account** and use your membership credentials to log in.

Step 2: Click on the **Academic Books** link under “Read”.

Step 3: Browse through subjects or look up a book or author through the search bar.

Step 4: you can read chapters online or download them for offline use. Download **Adobe Digital Editions** by selecting your device in the pop-up to read downloaded chapters.
